In 1808, Robert Mills, architect and prison reform advocate, was looking for someone to build the prison he had designed to implement his vision of reform. Burlington County needed a jail in Mount Holly to replace the 1760's county jail in Burlington City. The two met. The result -- the key step in prison design for reformation represented by the Old Burlington County Prison, in use from 1811 until 1965. With the **possible** exception of our neighbor, Eastern State Penitentiary, it is the most significant prison building in the United States.
